PART II ASSEMBLY

The second part of the Village Sampler Quilt involves assembly of strip number two. Sections included in this strip are as follows: The General's House Section, the Meeting House Section, and The Two Brothers House Section. Assembly instructions for each section are included with the individual section's Template Diagrams printouts. A "piece/fabric cutting guide" for each section is listed below.

PART II ... PIECE/FABRIC CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Cut one of each piece number unless otherwise noted.

Sky Blue ... Piece number 1, 2, 4, 5, 7, 8, and 15

Medium Light Green Grass ... Piece number 20/20R, 22, 23, and 24

Bone ... Piece number 18 and 19

Red Brick ... Piece number 6, 9, 11, four total of 10, and two total of 13

Black ... Piece number 3

Dark Gold ... Piece number 14

Yellow ... Piece number 25 and two total of 12

Cream/Tan Print ... Piece number 21

Gray (foundation) ... Piece number 17 and two total of 16

Medium Green Grass ... Piece number 11, 13, 14, 19, and 21

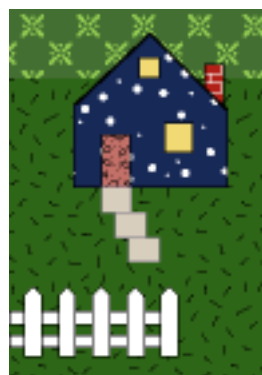
Black ... Piece number 2, 8/8R, and 12

Yellow ... Piece number 5 and 19

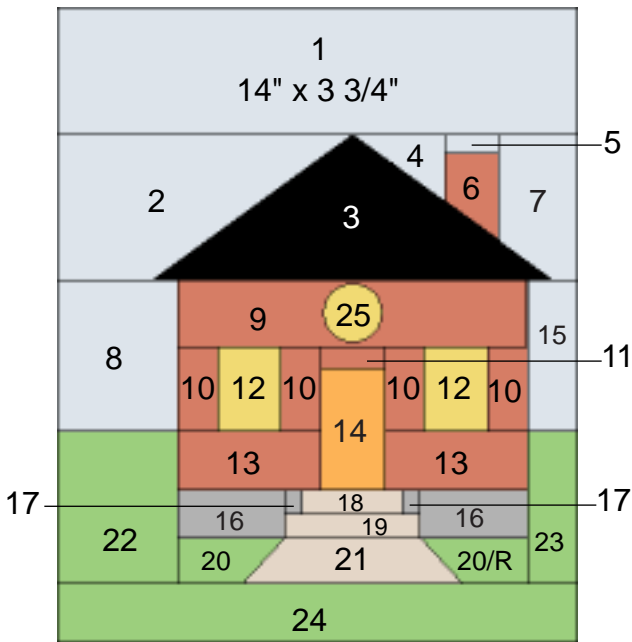
Bone ... Three total of piece number 23

White ... Ten total of piece number 28 and five total of 30

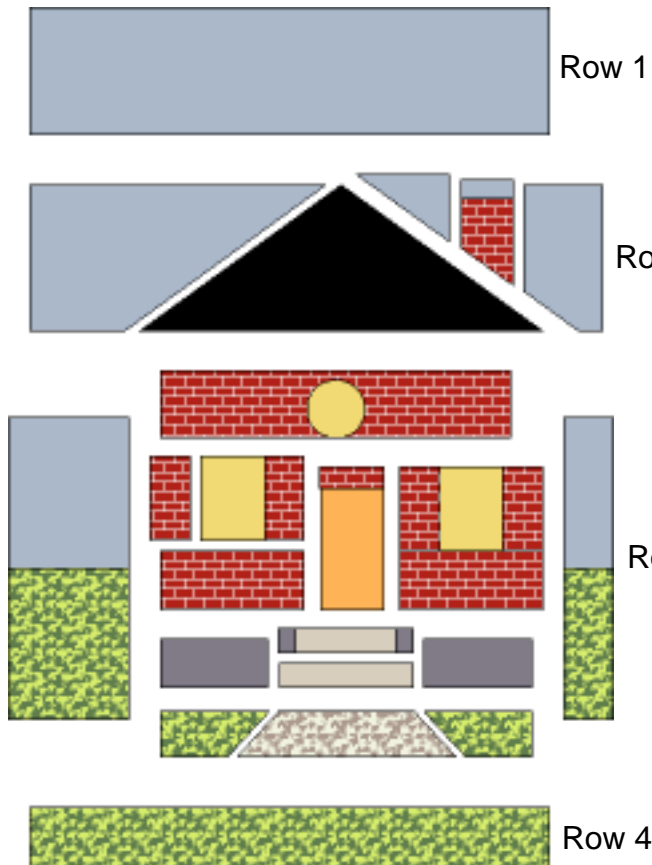

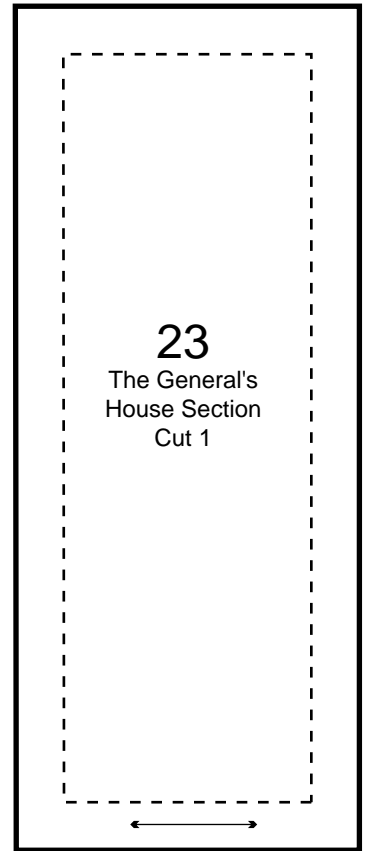
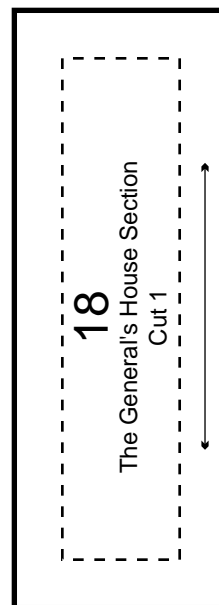
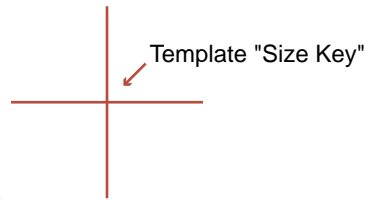
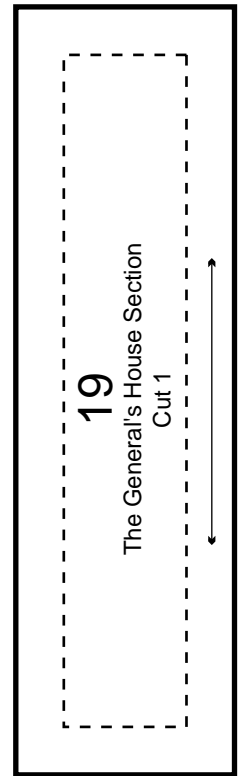
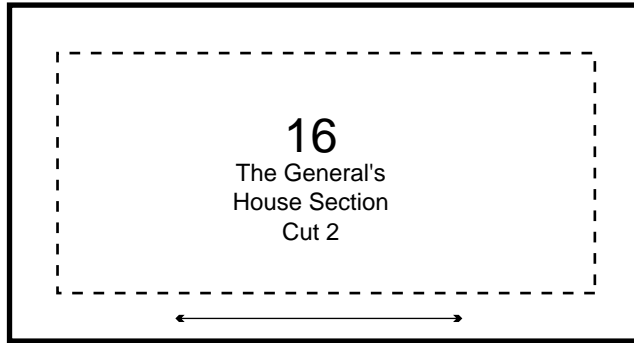
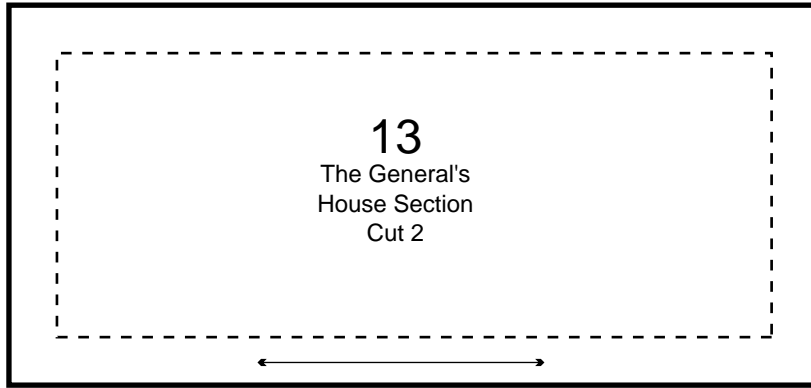
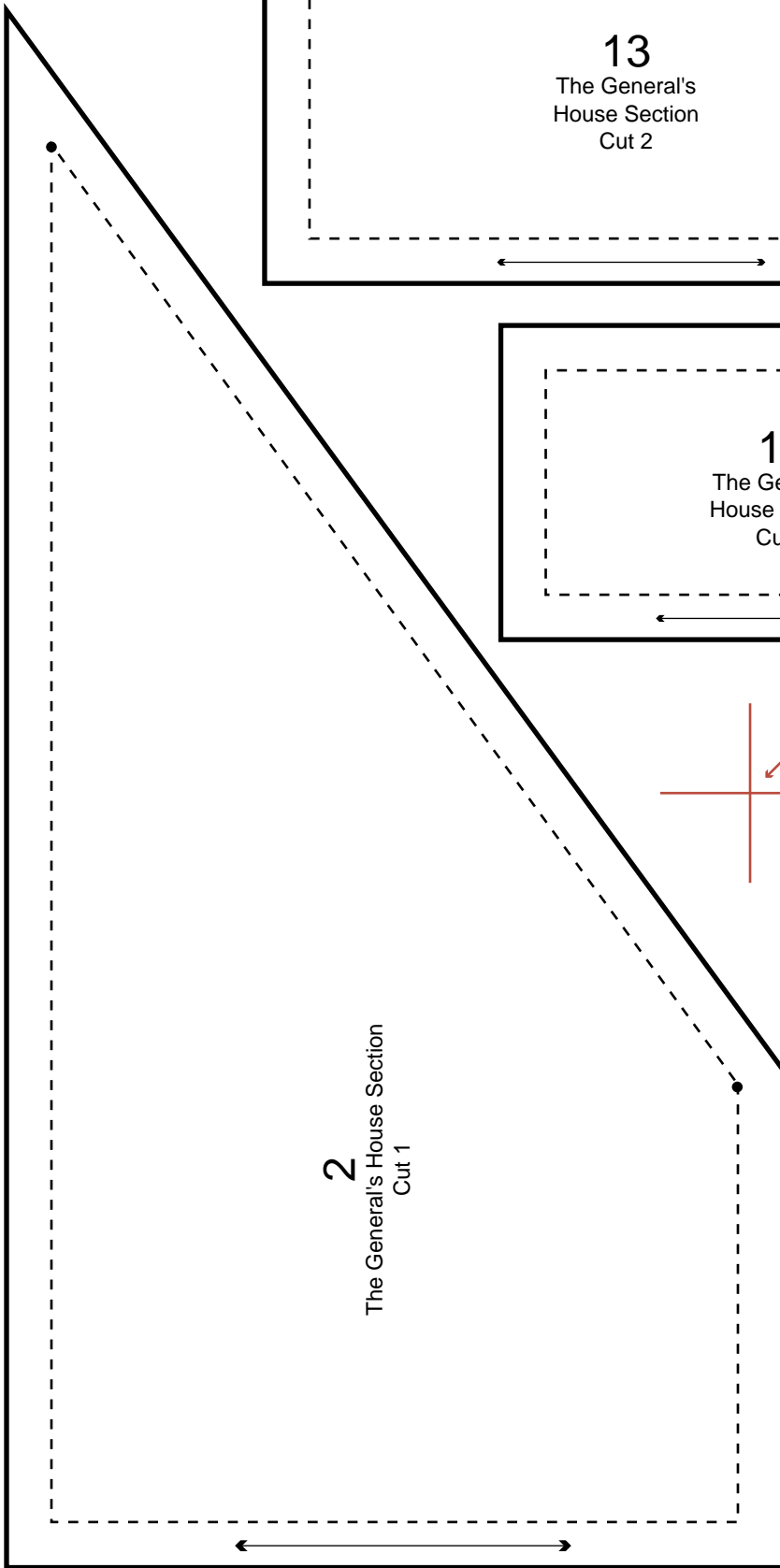
Template "Size Key" ... After printing, templates will be the correct size when both the horizontal and vertical line measures one inch.

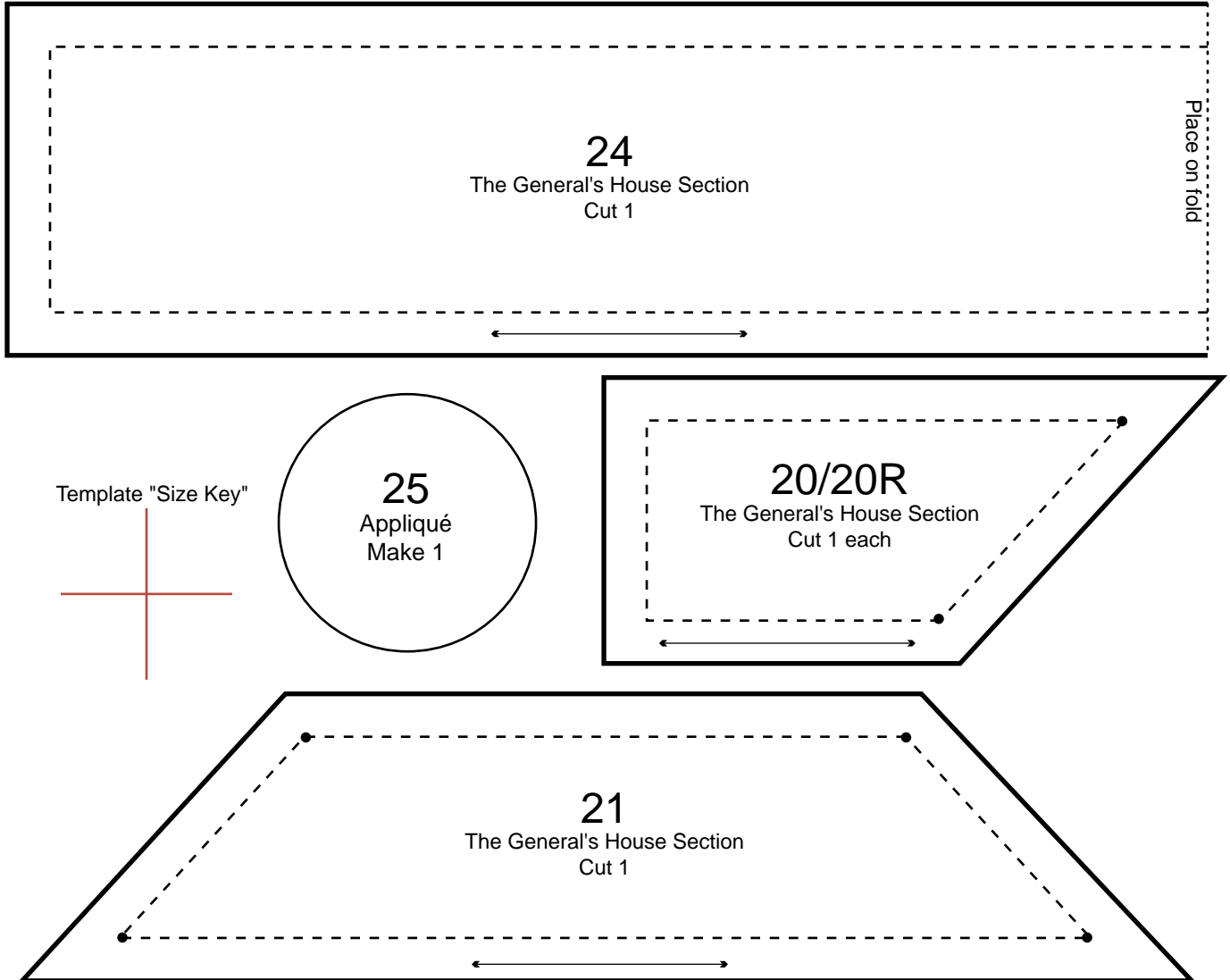
Template "Size Key"

Appliqué Round Window ... Transfer round window outline (Piece 25) to a lightweight piece of cardboard (poster board works well) and cut out circle as accurately as possible. (A flat washer the size of the window can also be used.) Lay the template or washer on the wrong side of the fabric and draw a line around it. Cut out fabric circle, adding seam allowance. Run a basting stitch, by hand, along the outside edge of the fabric. Leave long threads at the beginning and end of the seam (Diagram 1). Center the template or washer in the center of the fabric circle and pull the threads tight around it. This eases the fullness in evenly. Press seam allowance, loosen threads and remove template. Pull basting threads again and carefully tie them together, making sure the fabric lies flat. Cut off excess basting thread. Appliqué window into place. (Tip: If appliquéing a round window is not preferred, use a yellow button.)
